VBS 2024 Wrap Up  
*Clues to Christ*

As the inspired Word of God, every page of the Bible contains information that is vital for our everyday lives. Chief among them is the truth of forgiveness and salvation that is only through faith in Jesus Christ, the Son of God, who died on the cross to pay for our sins (John 20:31). Another truth the Scriptures reveal is the faithfulness of our God.

Each chapter of the Bible unfolds the passage of time and the working of God through it all. Jesus told two disciples that he was the key to understanding all the Scriptures (Luke 24:27). This is of course true because the Word of God is Christ and it is all about him. Every bit of the Old Testament points ahead to Jesus, and every part of the New Testament flows forth from Christ and his work of salvation.

For our Vacation Bible School program this year, we followed some of the clues of the Old Testament that lead to Christ and events in the New Testament that foreshadowed what would happen with Jesus. Each day had a Bible story, a memorable point to take home, and a Bible verse to memorize, among other things. Here is a bit about each day:

*Day 1—The Fall into Sin*, from Genesis 3:1–24. God’s perfect creation was ruined by the sin of Adam and Eve, who ate the forbidden fruit. But, in the curses announced by God was found the first promise of the Christ. Genesis 3:15 says, “I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel.” The offspring of the woman would be the Christ. He would crush the serpent’s head in his own death, the very blow against his heel struck by the serpent.

Take Home Point: God promises to save us from sin.

Memory Verse: 1 Corinthians 15:22—For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive.

*Day 2—Bronze Serpent*, from Numbers 21:4–9. After 400 years of slavery, God rescued his people of the promise from Egypt. It did not take long for the Hebrew people to begin their complaints against Moses and God. As a result, God sent venomous snakes to punish the people. They repented and begged Moses for help. God instructed Moses to fashion a snake of bronze and to secure it to a pole. Whenever the bitten people looked at the snake on the pole, they were healed and saved. Jesus connects this with himself in his words to Nicodemus from John 3, which is the memory verse below.

Take Home Point: God forgives us.

Memory Verse: John 3:14—“And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life.”

*Day 3—Annunciation and Angel’s Visit to Joseph*, from Luke 1 and Matthew 1. After 400 years of silence from God, Mary and Joseph were visited separately by angels, announcing the coming conception and birth of the Christ. They were to give him the name Jesus, which comes from the Hebrew name Joshua, meaning “he saves.” At long last, the fulfillment of the promise made to Adam and Eve was at hand. In the words of the angels, clues were given as to the person and work of the Christ. He would be called the Son of the Most High (God), he would rule over Israel forever (man and God), and he would save his people from their sins (savior).

Take Home Point: Jesus came for us.

Memory Verse: Matthew 1:21—“She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins.”

*Day 4—Jesus Raises Lazarus*, from John 11. In this beloved story, Jesus arrives on the scene of Lazarus’s tomb four days after his friend’s death. All are overwhelmed by this man’s death and eager to see what Jesus would do. Jesus called out to Lazarus to come out of the tomb, and he did, Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead with the power of his voice and word. This great clue points ahead to the death of Jesus and his own resurrection, which in turn points ahead to our death and our resurrection.

Take Home Point: Jesus gives us life.

Memory Verse: John 11:25—Jesus said to her, “I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live...”

*Day 5—Road to Emmaus*, from Luke 24:13–35. This final story for our VBS gives us the foundation for the claim that all Scripture is about Jesus, as mentioned before. Jesus had been crucified, died, and was buried. On the day he rose again from the dead, two followers of Jesus left Jerusalem for the village of Emmaus. Jesus walks with these disciples, but keeps them from recognizing him. He wants them to recount all that happened to Jesus, and then he connected the dots for them with those events and their predictions from the Old Testament. Jesus is the perfect and complete fulfillment of all of God’s promises for our salvation. And because of Jesus, we can be sure that all of God’s promises are true and will come true.

Take Home Point: Jesus is our Savior.

Memory Verse: John 20:31—But these things are written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.

Our VBS followed a site rotation which included an opening program, craft, games, snack, storytelling, Bible challenge, and closing program. I give thanks to God for the many volunteers who helped make VBS possible. And thank you to Sara McPike, who served as our VBS Director and creator of our theme for the year. I look forward to another VBS next summer and I ask that you pray that the Lord continue to work through this service offered at St. John.

### Hymnals and a Hymn Sing




